ABOUT THIS WALK

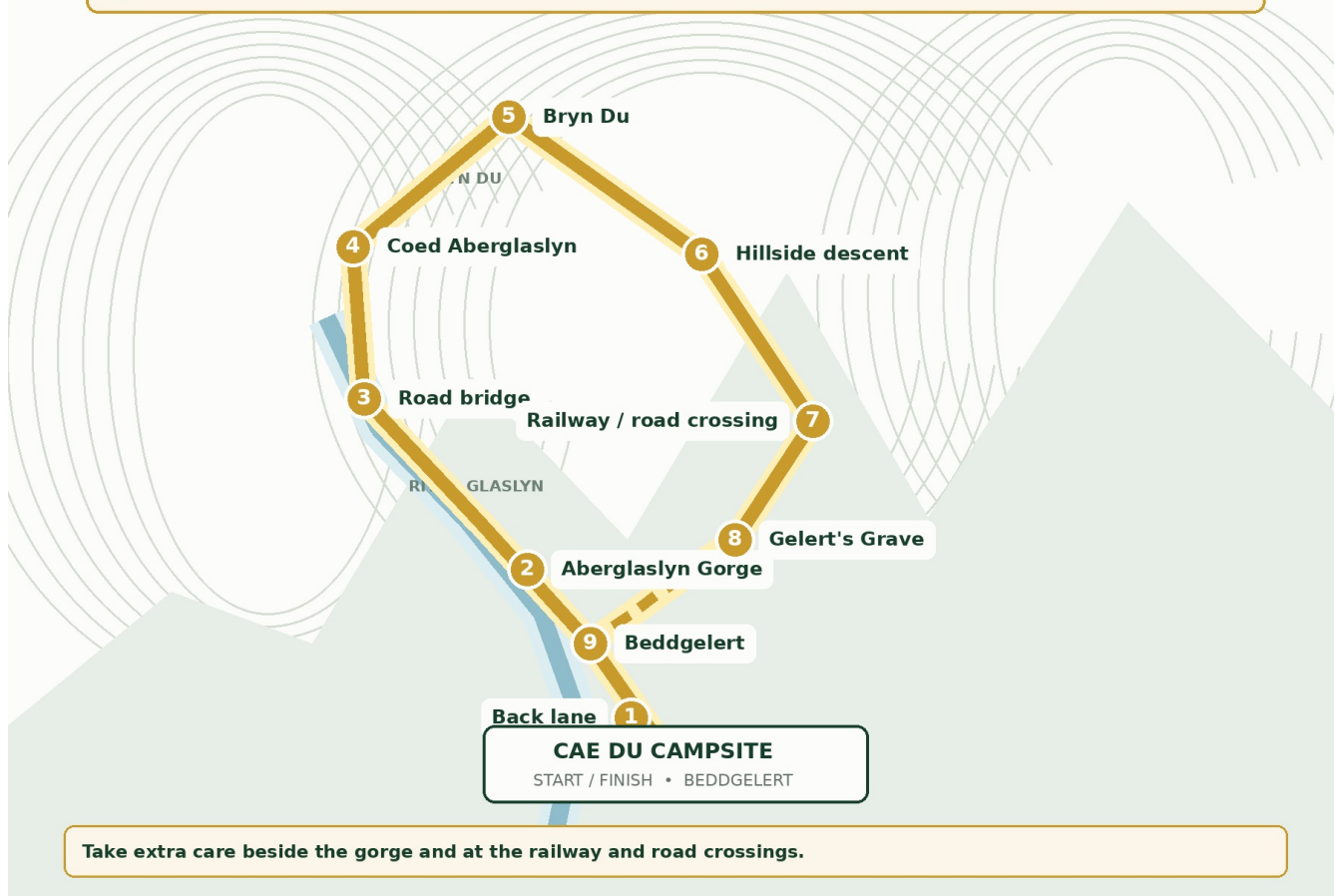
A varied circular walk through Beddgelert and Aberglaslyn Gorge, over Bryn Du and back via Gelert's Grave. Expect riverside paths, woodland and open hillside.

STEP-BY-STEP ROUTE

Aberglaslyn, Bryn Du & Beddgelert



Follow the route

Use the numbered directions alongside the route map on page one.

- 1 Leave Cae Du through one of the gates onto the back lane. Turn right and follow the lane into Beddgelert.
- 2 Do not cross the footbridge in the village. Instead, follow the River Glaslyn downstream as it enters Aberglaslyn Gorge.
- 3 Continue to the kissing gate, pass through it and cross the road bridge. Turn left along the road.
- 4 Around the bend, look for the National Trust sign for Coed Aberglaslyn and take the footpath on the right. Follow it to the stream, turn right up the steps and follow the waymarkers through the woods.
- 5 Cross the stile onto Bryn Du. An optional short detour leads to the small tower on top of the hill.
- 6 Descend through the gate to the ruined building with the fallen tree. Cross the stile, turn left along the top of the field and follow the path down towards the railway.
- 7 Cross the railway and road with care. Pass through the gate opposite and follow the track to a small wooden gate on the left.
- 8 Go through the gate and take the left fork to Gelert's Grave and the nearby sculpture.
- 9 Continue to Beddgelert, turn right and cross the bridge. Retrace the back lane to Cae Du.

BEFORE YOU SET OFF

Distances and times are approximate. Check the weather, wear suitable footwear and carry water. Paths may be steep, uneven or slippery. Use this guide with a detailed map or offline navigation.

ROUTE NOTE

Take particular care beside the gorge and at the railway and road crossings. Check carefully in both directions before crossing.
